Please take 5 minutes to read these file specifications, to make sure that your design is 100% perfect, creatively and technically. The printed or cutted result will then be exactly as you expect it. If you supply us with your professional design there will be no problems printing or cutting your files. We than can guarantee that your designs will be of high quality and delivered in time. ## File specifications print design

### General

- Convert all text to outline and mention the font type used.
- Specify the scale used.
- Colors on your monitor are not printing colors.
- A color print from your desktop printer cannot be used as a color reference.

### Use of Colors

Files can be supplied in both CMYK (Euroscale coated) or RGB (Adobe RGB 1998). In order to maximize the color gamut we recommend using RGB color mode.

You can use PMS Colors. However, these spot colors will be converted to CMYK in our high-end RIP's, according to the Pantone spot to process color library.

### Resolution

All images used must have a minimum resolution of 150 dpi, at full size. Please keep this in mind when images are created in a smaller scale.

### Document information

Give your files a clear description.

## File specifications cut design

### General

Mention the required colors of your sign PMS colors will be approximated In cutting vinyl of digitally printed.

### Document type

All files need to be Adobe Illustrator EPS, vector.

### Document information

Give your files a clear description.

### Text to outline

Convert all text to outline and mention the font type used.

### Line thickness

Line thickness cannot be cut. Please use outline stroke.

### Gradient

Never use gradient fills and don't import files. When your design has a gradient fill (for example from light to dark) your file will be printed and cut later by OPOS Cutting.



### PDF specification

Page bleed to be discussed.

Always check the final result of your PDF file.

There are 2 ways to find out how your PDF file will be printed:

- Open your PDF file in Acrobat Reader 8 or higher and activate 'Output preview' (of Output example) (Preferences > Page preview)
- Open your PDF in Acrobat Professional and look at Advanced > Output preview and check your design.



### Adobe Illustrator file

When using Illustrator CS2 of higher you can create a PDF file using the Indesign CS 2-3 PDF export settings. These settings work good when using Illustrator. We advise you not to use 'open' files.



### Adobe Photoshop or TIFF file

When using Photoshop CS2 of higher you can create a PDF file using the Standard PDF Export settings (High Quality Print). We advise you not to use 'open' files.

## Adobe InDesign file

When using Illustrator CS2 or higher you can create a PDF file using the InDesign CS 2-3 PDF export settings. We advise you not to use 'open' files.



## Other file formats

We can use CorelDraw files. Please export your design from CorelDraw to one of the following file formats: PDF, PSD, TIFF, JPG or EPS.

## Microsoft<sup>®</sup> Office
